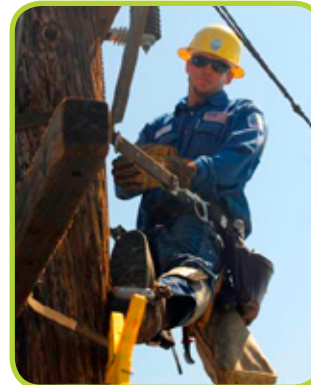
Upon graduation, apprentices will be promoted to a "Journey Level" position, earning competitive wages with the possibility of overtime and bonuses.

Line Mechanic Apprentice

During your three-and-a-half-year state-certified apprenticeship program, learn construction and maintenance of overhead and underground power transmission and distribution lines. You must be able to work at heights and with energized voltage systems.



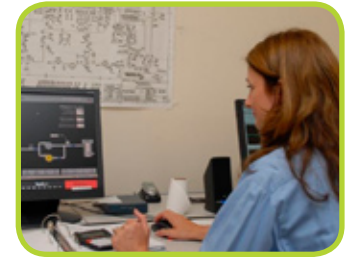
Pipefitter Apprentice

This four-year program will help you build, repair, and maintain the City's water infrastructure. Your skills will be put to good use

installing and inspecting water mains, fire hydrants, meters and valves.

Power Plant Operator Trainee

During this two-year training program, you will work on rotating shifts and will learn the operation of a turbo-electric generating plant, including turbines, boilers, pumps, and power plant controls and instrument systems.



Power Plant Maintenance Trainee

Through this two-year program, you will learn all aspects of power plant maintenance required to assist

mechanics in the assembly and disassembly of power plant equipment.



Electrician Apprentice

In this four-year program, you will learn construction and maintenance of the power production plant

and electric distribution stations and substations.



Test Technician Apprentice

In this four-year program, you will learn field and laboratory testing of electrical and electronic equipment and materials used in a power utility.
