

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

for the Burbank Water and Power Campus Stormwater Project

This serves as the City of Burbank's Notice of Intent to adopt a recirculated Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Burbank Water & Power Campus Stormwater Improvement Project, prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), CEQA Guidelines, and local implementation procedures.

- Project Description: The project proposes construction of stormwater improvements on the Burbank Water & Power (BWP) campus and the adjacent off-site storm water drainage system in order to comply with Regional, State, and Federal water quality standards. The project proposes to construct drainage improvements that would allow stormwater from adjacent properties to be intercepted and discharged into the Burbank Western Channel (BWC), a tributary of the Los Angeles River, through a new outfall structure. Once separated, on-site runoff would be largely retained on the BWP Campus and either infiltrated into the groundwater or used for cooling tower make-up (replenishment) water.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the City proposes to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the above-referenced project. The MND is based on the finding that the project's environmental effects would be less than significant with adherence to mitigation measures included in the Initial Study. The reasons to support such a finding are documented by an Initial Study prepared by the City. This notice is being recirculated with a new public review period to incorporate revisions to the Tribal Cultural Resources mitigation measures. The Initial Study, the proposed MND, and supporting materials are available for review at the City of Burbank, Burbank Water & Power, 164 W. Magnolia Blvd., Burbank, CA, 91502, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to noon and 1:00 to 5:00 p.m. and at the City of Burbank Water and Power website, [https://www.burbankwaterandpower.com/stormwaterproject]. The environmental documents are also available for public review at the Community Services Building located at 150 North Third Street, Burbank, CA 91502, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Written comments regarding the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration must be submitted to the Burbank Water & Power prior to 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the 30-day public review/comment period (July 22, 2022).
