



UNDERGROUND CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Frequently Asked Questions

What type of work is being performed?

BWP is installing underground electric conduit and cable in City streets to support the construction of a new substation at 228 S. Naomi Street. This work will involve excavating open trenches in the street to install conduit, manholes, and underground electrical cables. Large equipment such as backhoes, concrete trucks, bucket trucks, and small cranes will be used to complete the work. See the reverse side for a map of the construction area.

When will the work take place?

Conduit construction begins in March 2023 and will continue until summer 2023. The working hours will be Monday through Friday from 7:00 am until 7:00 pm each day. Street lane closures will be generally limited to 8:30 am to 3:30 pm.

Who is performing the work?

All work will be performed by BWP field crews and our contractor, Doty Bros Construction Company.

Will you need access to my property?

No, we will not need access to your property for this project. Our work will mainly take place in the street. If in the rare instance that BWP requests access to your property, look to see that the BWP staff person is wearing a BWP uniform, drives a BWP vehicle and gladly provides their BWP ID badge. Will traffic be affected? What is the traffic plan?

Yes, our contractors will be using a City approved traffic plan to redirect traffic flow around the construction area. Proper signs, traffic cones and

traffic guards will be used as necessary to minimize the day-to-day impact. Speeds will be reduced in the area of construction.

Will parking be affected?

As work progresses, "No Parking" signs will be placed around the area of construction to assist with traffic flow. These signs will be posted a minimum of 48 hours in advance.

Will I be able to get in or out of my driveway?

Access to your driveway may be temporarily blocked for short durations. When this happens, you will be notified and work will not begin until scheduling is coordinated with you.

Will the contractor leave a big mess?

Our contractors will use necessary dust control and street cleanup as needed to keep the job site and the City streets clean.

Will there be noise?

This type of construction requires the use of heavy equipment and machinery, which can be noisy. We understand this may be a concern and will do our best to limit this noise to the construction working hours.
